Riding on a wave of opulence

SUPER SNEAK PEEK: QUEST NEWSPAPERS WAS INVITED ABOARD A SUPER YACHT THAT DOCKED AT RIVERGATE MARINA, MURARRIE. REPORTER BIANCA SULLIVAN TAKES A GUIDED TOUR

CAPTAIN Bruno Herregods has held the top job of steering 48m super yacht *Slojo* across the seas to glamorous destinations for four years.

Capt Herregods and his 10 crew left the Rivergate Marina at Murarrie to continue their second cruise through the Pacific after visiting the Galapagos Islands, French Polynesia, Fiji, New Caledonia, Australia and New Zealand.

The motor yacht, which was built in Seattle in the US and launched in 2008, boasts high-end fixtures and fittings, as well as a large master bedroom with ensuite, sundeck with a spa, and helicopter pad.

The yacht can accommodate nine guests in addition to crew members.

When not aboard the super yacht, Capt Herregods said he spends time at his apart-

ment in St Maarten in the Caribbean.

"We love travelling so even when we are not on *Slojo* it's rare to find us there," Capt Herregods said. While cruising the world, the owner and crew of *Slojo* are involved in Yacht Aid Global to support local schools by donating educational supplies.

"Yacht Aid Global is a small non-profit organisation set up and run by a former yacht captain who recognised there was a need to get the super yacht community involved with charity work in places that they visit," Capt Herregods said.

"To date we have raised over \$70,000 through the crew and owner's efforts and have made donations all over the Pacific.

"We donate everything from school supplies to cooking equipment."
